FACTS

(Made under Section 192 of CPA. Cap 20 R.E 2002)

On 11th day of March, 2015 at around 07:45hrs at Ibinza Nyamadoke area within Ilemela District in Mwanza City, while the police officers were in operation of arresting traditional healers who practice without being registered did arrest the accused who was practicing as a Traditional Health practitioner without being lawfully registered.

However, when search was amounted in her house she was found in unlawful possession of Government Trophies namely, four (4) wild beast tails valued at T.Shs. 4,345,900/=, one piece of grey headed king fisher valued at T. Shs. 83,575/=, two (2) pieces of lion skins valued at T.Shs. 890,350/=, one piece of given skin worth T.Shs. 334,300/=, one piece of Duiker skin valued at T.shs. 468,020/= all total valued at **T.Shs. 6,122,145/=**.

After that search, the accused person was arraigned in court due to above facts.



STATEMENT OF OFFENCE

UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF GOVERNMENT TROPHIES, Contrary to Section 86(1) of the Wildlife Conservation Act No.5 of 2009 read together with Paragraph 14(d) of the First Schedule to the Economic and Organized Crimes Control Act Cap.200 [R.E. 2002].
