**RULLING**

The all accused charged with Unlawful dealing in government Trophies Contrary to Section 80(1) and section 84(1) of the Wildlife Conservation Act No. 5 of 2009 read together with paragraph 14(b) of the first Schedule, and section 57(1) and Section 60(1) of The Economic and Organized Crime Act[Cap 200 R:E 2009] the matter alleged to occur on diverse dates between 1<sup>st</sup> January 2002 and 13<sup>th</sup> June 32014 at diverse places within Dodoma Region, jointly and together, transported and sold Government Trophies to wit; 18 Elephant Tusk weighing 326.5 Kgs, valued at Tanzania Shillings two hundred twenty eight million, eighty hundred twenty five hundred thousand(Tsh 228,825,000/=)only, the property of the United Republic of Tanzania, without a trophy dealers license or a permit from the Director of Wildlife

During the hearing of the matter the prosecution side was no longer desirous to proceed prosecuting the case as by virtue of Section 91(1) of Criminal Procedure Code [Cap 20 R:E 2002].

Therefore this matter is hereby marked withdrawn under Section 91(1) of Criminal Procedure Code [Cap 20 R: E 2002]. I hereby consequently discharged all the accused.
