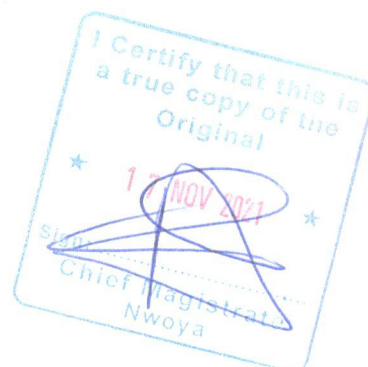

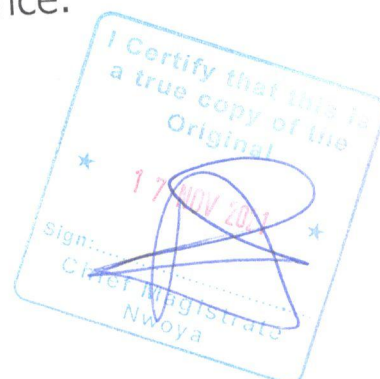
Court:
