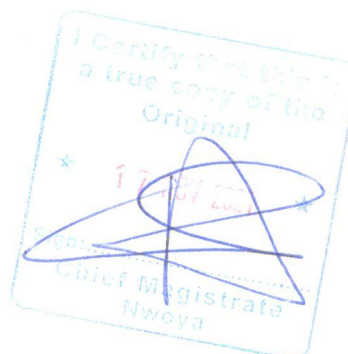
Court: Plea of guilty on both counts.

Court: Both accused persons are convicted on their own plea of guilt on both counts.

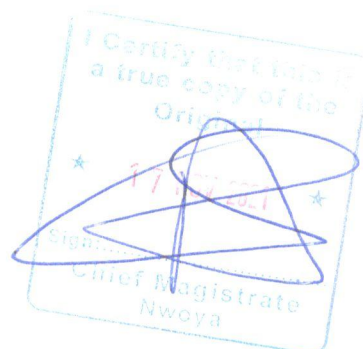
Pros: Allocutus: No record of previous record of conviction, on count 1, I am praying for 6 months imprisonment.
