Akoko : Brief facts are that both accused on 7/8/2021 while at Pawatomero Village in Nwoya were found in possession of 5 pieces of smoked wild meat, fresh thigh of Uganda Kob which they could not account for. Since they did not have permission, they were arrested and charged.

A1 : Facts are correct.

A2 : Facts are true.

Court : Both accused are convicted on their



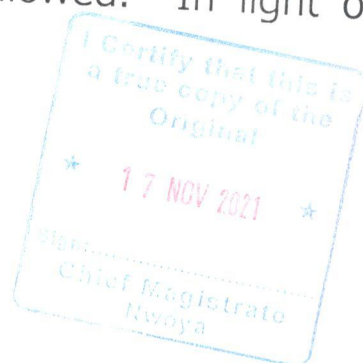
respective pleas.

Akoko : No record of previous conviction, this being a strict hostility offence, I pray for a custodial sentence of 5 years or fine of Shs. 2,000,000/=

Conrad : The two convicts are first time offenders, they are husband and wife and parents to two young children who are at home unattended to, this being a count of justice, I pray that it takes into account of the welfare of the children. We pray for a caution for A2 and a fine for A1 for Shs. 500,000/=

A2 : I am diabetic and have a problem with the heart. It was A1 who brought the meat.

Count : Both accused have not wasted court's time, they are remorseful, the smoked meat brought by A1 for A2 (wife) to cook, but she was also aware that the meat was for a wild animal that is not allowed. In light of the



following, I sentence both accused as follows.

A1. Sentenced to a fine of Shs. 1,000,000/=, in default he serves five years imprisonment.

A2. Sentenced to a fine of Shs. 200,000/=, in default she serves 6 months imprisonment.
