CII: I have understood the charge and it is true.

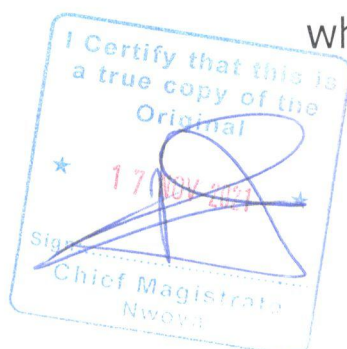
CIII: I have understood the charge and it is true.

Pros: Brief Facts for 3 counts:

On 24/3/2018, accused and others still at large illegally entered got coro a place found within the Murchison falls conservation area without the permission from Uganda Wildlife Authority.

Upon being arrested by the game rangers, accused was found with three wheel traps, 3 spears, one axe, one knife and fresh game meat of Uganda Kop upon accused being arrested with all these items, the accused was transferred to Nwoya Police Station where the items recovered where properly



exhibited and I pray to tender in the exhibit slips and accused was then charged with the three counts as per the charge sheet.

Accused: The facts are true as stated by prosecution.

Court: The exhibit slips is admitted on court record, and accused is hereby convicted on his plea of guilt on all the three counts.

Pros: For Previous Record.

am praying to court to give me three months so that I can serve and go back and take care of my young children.

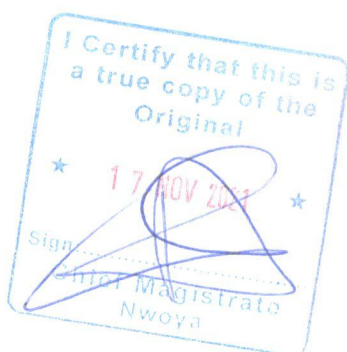
Court: The convict is remanded to the 19/4/18 for sentencing.
