Court:

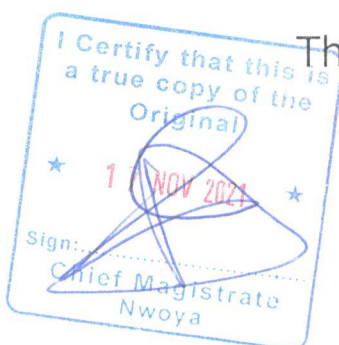
Plea of guilty entered on both counts against both accused persons.

Pros Allocutus: On count one, I am praying for 8 months, 2nd count 2 years and this is because we do not have any previous criminal record of the convicts.

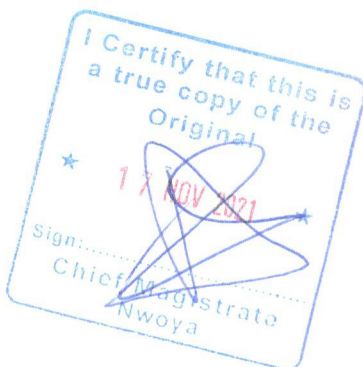
Convict in mitigation:
