Court: Accused persons are convicted on their own plea and they are remanded to 30/8/18 for Allocutus, mitigation and sentence.

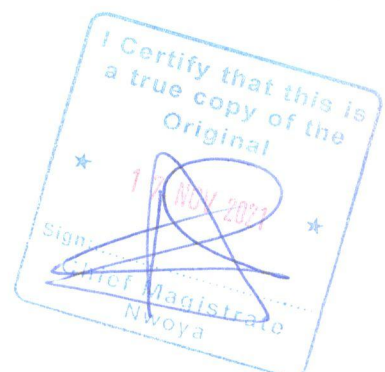

Prosecution Allocutus: The two convicts are first offender and on count one, I am praying for one year, count two, two years and count three, three years.

Mitigation by AI: I am asking court to forgive me, I am HIV/AIDS positive, I am a sole bread winner for my children and family because the drugs am I am very weak



and I cannot manage the conditions of prison.

The convicts are first offender with no known past criminal record they both pleaded guilty thus saving court's time and resources they both asked court to be lenient told court they are sole bread winners for their families. AI told court he is very weak because of the ARV drugs he is on for HIV/AIDS however the offences they are convicted off are so rampant within this court's jurisdiction and that calls for deterrence measures this in consideration and of the above, the convicts are sentenced to on count one to pay a fine of UGX.
