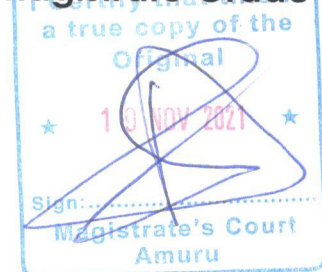

Court: Mitigation

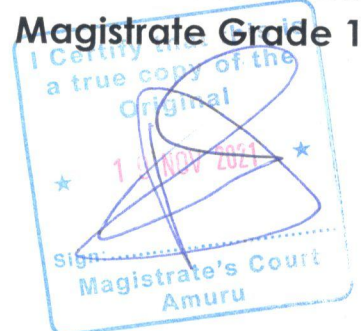
