Court: Accused is convicted on his own plea of guilty on both counts.

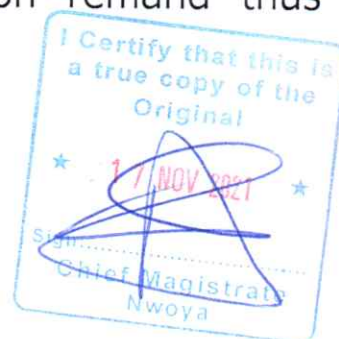
**Pros Allocutus:** On count one, we pray for 6 months.
