Court: Are these facts correct?

Accused: A1 – Its true

Court: You are convicted on the two charges on a plea of guilty.

State: No previous record of conviction. We take them as the first offenders. Since we have not gone through full trial, we pray they are cautioned and ordered not to appear in the Park for two years.
