Court: Plea of guilty on both counts against both accused.

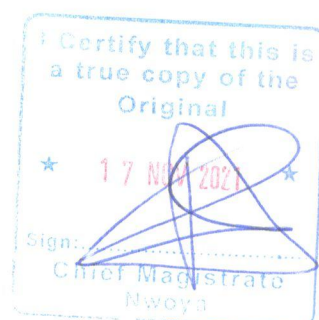
Pros: ***Brief Facts:***

A2 in Mitigation: I am praying for leniency; I have a family whom I look after.

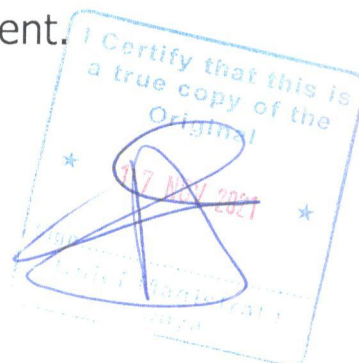
Court:
