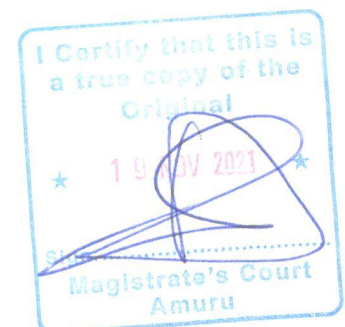

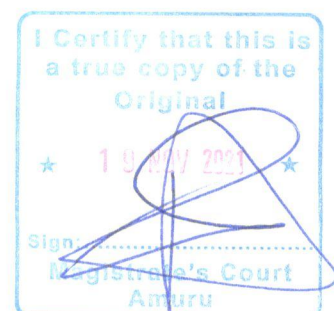

Court: The convicts have pleaded guilty. They have saved court's time. According to state, they are first time offenders. Looking at the nature of the offence, I sentence them as follows;

Count 1: Each to serve Community Service of 100 hours.

Count 2: Each to serve Community Service of 200 hours.

The sentence shall be served from Purongo Health Centre IV starting Monday 10.04.2017. in total, the convicts will serve 300 hours of Community Service. In default, they will each serve one-year imprisonment for the 2 counts. Rights of appeal explained.
