Court- accused person is hereby convicted of unlawful entry into a wildlife protected area without authority.


Court- matter adj to 24/04/2019 for sentencing.

Pros—Matter is for sentencing. Convict is a first offender – but wildlife offences are on the rise. Unlawful possession carries a fine of not less than 1 or 5 yrs in prison or both. I pray for a custodial sentence.

Convict- I pray for a lenient sentence.

Court-

Illegal entry c/s 74(a) UWA Act attracts a maximum sentence of 5years imprisonment or a fine of not less than 1m or both.

The convict seems remorseful, pleaded guilty and still a young man. Offences against the wildlife however discourages tourism and also threaten the survival of our wildlife and they are rampant.

Accordingly the convict will pay a fine of Ugx 1.8m or serve a prison sentence of 9 months in prison.
