When asked, he revealed he was a poacher and does the work with a one Masereka & Zake and Matiso Saverino (the joint accused's) their home were searched at AII's home they recovered rotten hippo meat, smoked, about 15 kgs, at A1's home the exhibit recovered other devices.

They were then arrested, the exhibit recovered and taken to police. They took their photographs. They were charged

The accused are all found guilty and ~~committed~~<sup>convicted</sup> as charged on their own plea of guilty. Court adjourned 27/02/2019 for mitigation and sentencing accused persons are remanded into custody.

The three accused have been successfully prosecuted ~~on~~<sup>on</sup> five counts which they admitted the prosecution has stated that the offences ~~are~~<sup>s</sup> are rampant. Although the convicts have prayed for forgiven, an appropriate sentence is hereby passed as follows:

1. Count 1. Fine of one million against Mateso and Masereka each or imprisonment for six months on count one.
2. Fine of shs one million against Mateso and Masereka each or imprisonment for six months on count two.
3. Fine of one million against Tibaijuka or imprisonment for six months for count three
4. Fine of shilling one million or imprisonment for six months against Tibaijuka for count four.
5. Imprisonment for six months against Tibaijuka for count five. The sentence run consecutively.

Right of appeal against the sentences explained.
